



STUDENT LEADERSHIP AMBASSADOR PROGRAM



The Student Leadership Ambassador Program provides opportunities for Imperial Valley College students interested in developing their leadership effectiveness while building stronger connections between IVC, future students, and the community at-large. IVC's Student Ambassadors assist and volunteer with the College's development events and enhance the welcoming of new students to the Imperial Valley College community. Additionally, Student Ambassadors serve as the face of IVC at a number of community relation events.

IVC's Leadership Ambassadors will be trained in **The Student Leadership Challenge**, a proven leadership training that has over 35 years of data and development behind it. Student Ambassadors will be required to attend one hour of training a week, which will include self-evaluation, peer to peer interaction, guest speakers and leadership theory discussions. It will be educational, soul searching and, most of all, FUN!!

The Student Leadership Challenge is a new addition to the Student Ambassador program. It is the first of its kind in the Valley and IVC.

It will become the premier program at IVC.

In addition to the Leadership Challenge, duties of the Ambassadors include:

- Assist with the Foundation's annual fundraising and development events.
- Provide assistance and participate in departmental and campus events such as First Step, Orientation, Golf Tournament, Hall of Fame and Commencement (among others).
- Other duties as assigned throughout the academic school year.

Priority Registration, Training & Stipend Information:

- Student Leadership Ambassador Program will receive priority registration when scheduling courses here at Imperial Valley College.
- Each Ambassador will receive a \$500 Scholarship per year (payable at \$250 and the end of each semester) after meeting the Ambassador requirements.

Student Ambassador Required Qualifications:

- Must be currently enrolled student at IVC or a first time student who intends to enroll in the following semester.
- Must maintain a 3.0 grade point average or higher and be enrolled in a minimum of six units per semester and be in good standing with the College.
- Be able to volunteer a minimum of 50 hours during each semester at approved Student Ambassador events.

Desirable Qualifications

- Graduate of any local Imperial Valley high school
- Valid California DL
- Bilingual
- Must have record of being a volunteer and leader in School or Community activities
