

CALCULATING YOUR ELIGIBILITY FOR IN-STATE TUITION (AB 540) IN CALIFORNIA

To calculate whether you meet the eligibility requirements for California's in-state tuition (AB 540), you will need to know about your:



- 1. Attendance at one or more of these California schools:
 - · Semesters attended in a California high school;
 - · Classroom hours completed in a California adult school;
 - Noncredit classroom hours (or in limited cases, semester and/or quarter units)
 completed at a California community college
 - Credits in semester and/or quarter units completed at a California community college;



- 2. At least one of these degree(s) earned in California:
 - High school diploma
 - GED
 - Associate degree
 - Minimum transfer requirements to a CSU or UC

You can find this information in the unofficial academic transcripts or attendance records of the California high school(s), adult school(s), and/or community college(s) you attended. You can also check in with your school counselor to learn how to calculate this information.

Important: Only classes taken after 2001 may be used to meet in-state tuition (AB 540) requirements.

What is considered full-time?

The attendance requirements used to meet in-state tuition (AB 540) must be equivalent to full-time. However, you can use part-time attendance to build up to full-time equivalency.

Type of School	1-Year Full-Time Attendance	3-Year Full-Time Attendance
High School	55 credits	165 credits
Adult School	420 classroom hours	1260 classroom hours
Community College (Credit courses)	24 semester credit units; or 36 quarter credit units	72 semester credit units; or 108 quarter credit units
Community College (Noncredit courses)	420 classroom hours	1260 classroom hours
