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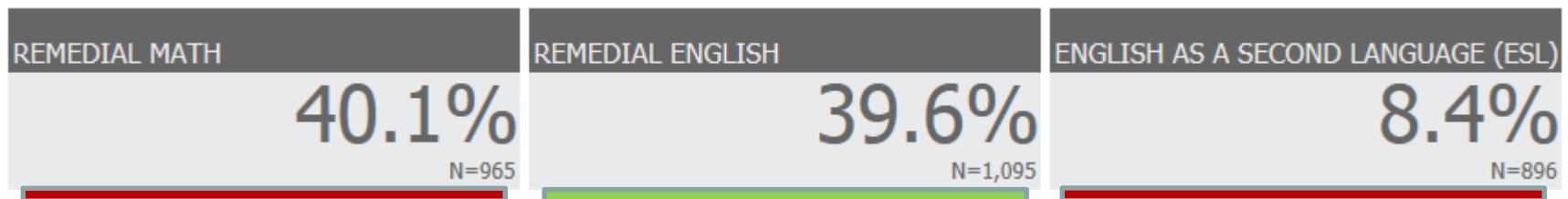
Remedial Cohort

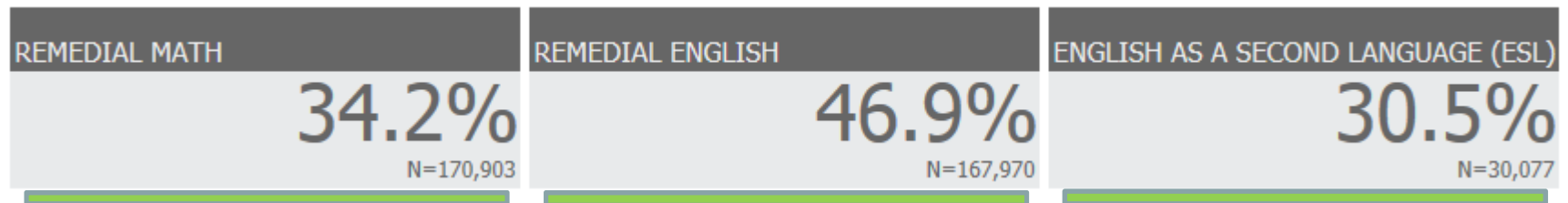

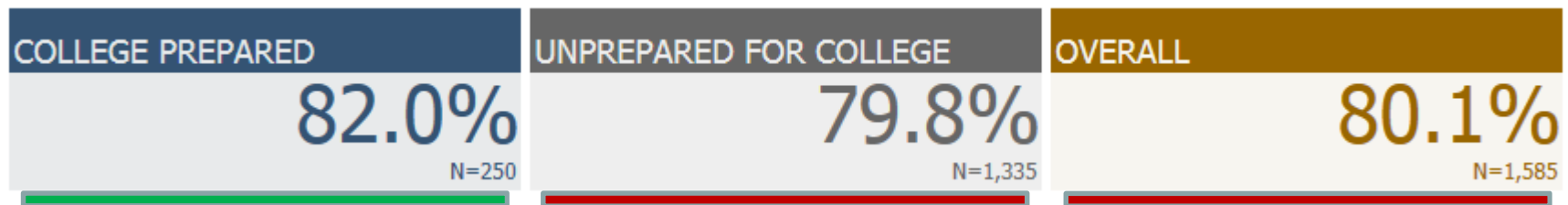

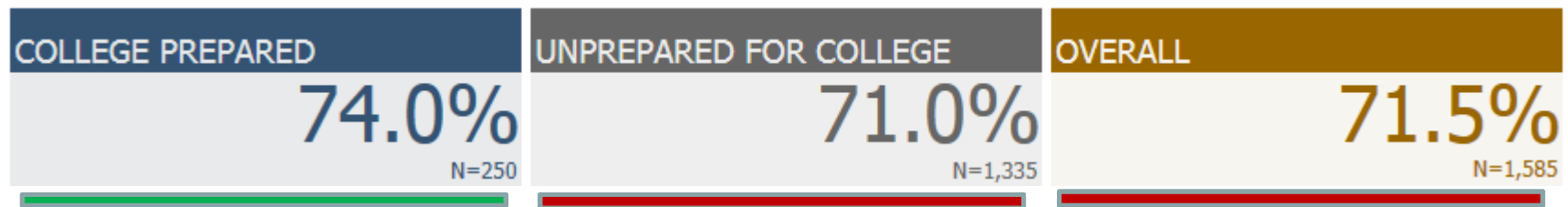

Percentage of degree, certificate and/or transfer-seeking students starting first time in 2010-11 tracked for six years through 2015-16 who achieved at least 30 units.

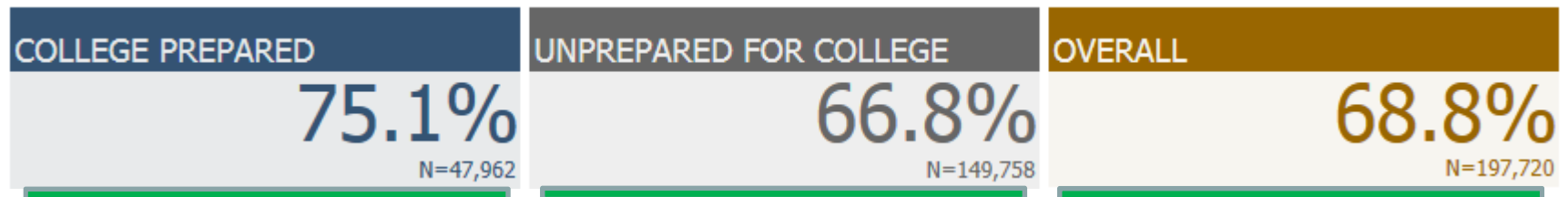

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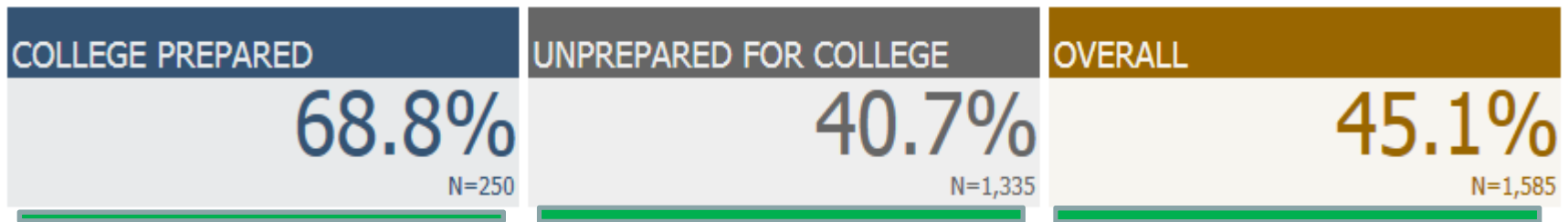

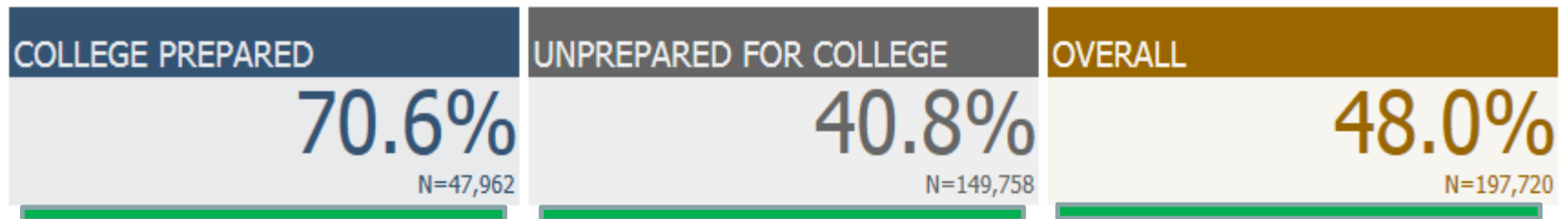


Completion Rates

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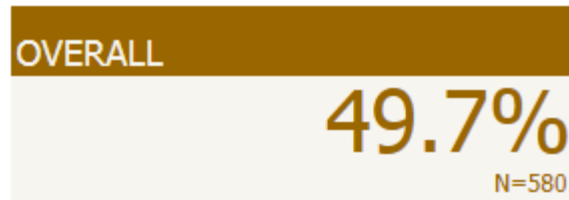
Career Technical Education (CTE)
