First Math and English courses attempted were college-level courses

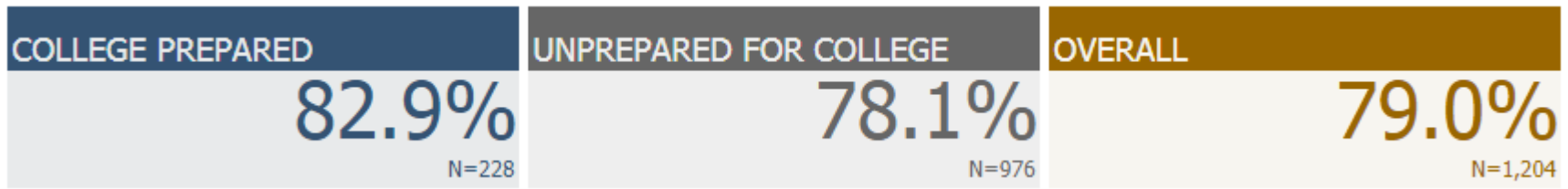

Percentage of degree, certificate and/or transfer-seeking students starting first time in 2010-11 tracked for six years through 2016-17 who achieved at least 30 units.

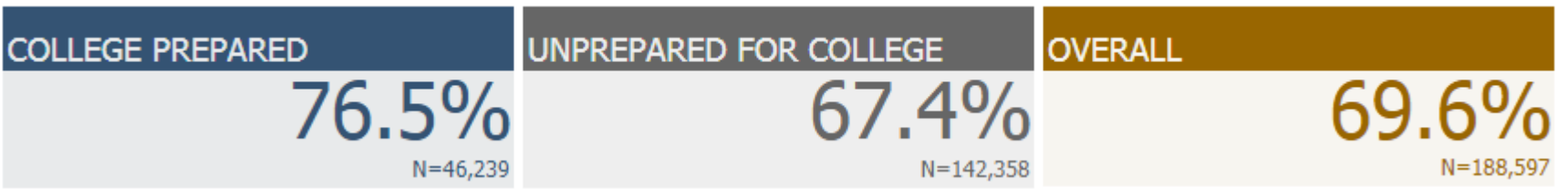

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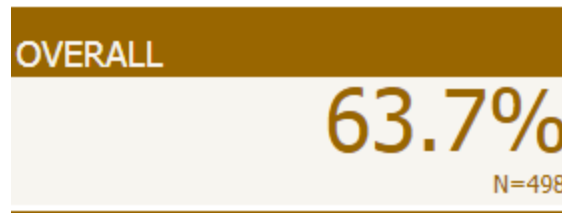
Career Technical Education (CTE)

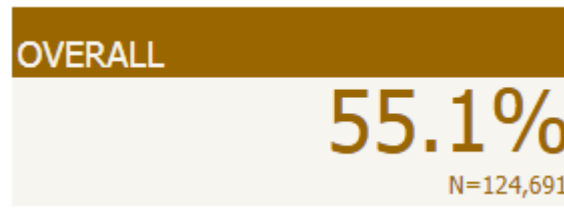


CTE Rates
